The GWSR uses DMU's regularly but due to a lack of serviceable vehicles it is almost a year since they were last used. We normally require traction to be driven every 6 months to maintain competence. To address this, the most senior traction inspector, with the longest familiarity with DMU's will reacquaint himself with the preparation, driving and disposal of the units on a non-public running day. He will then train and assess others as well as being formally assessed by another traction inspector.
